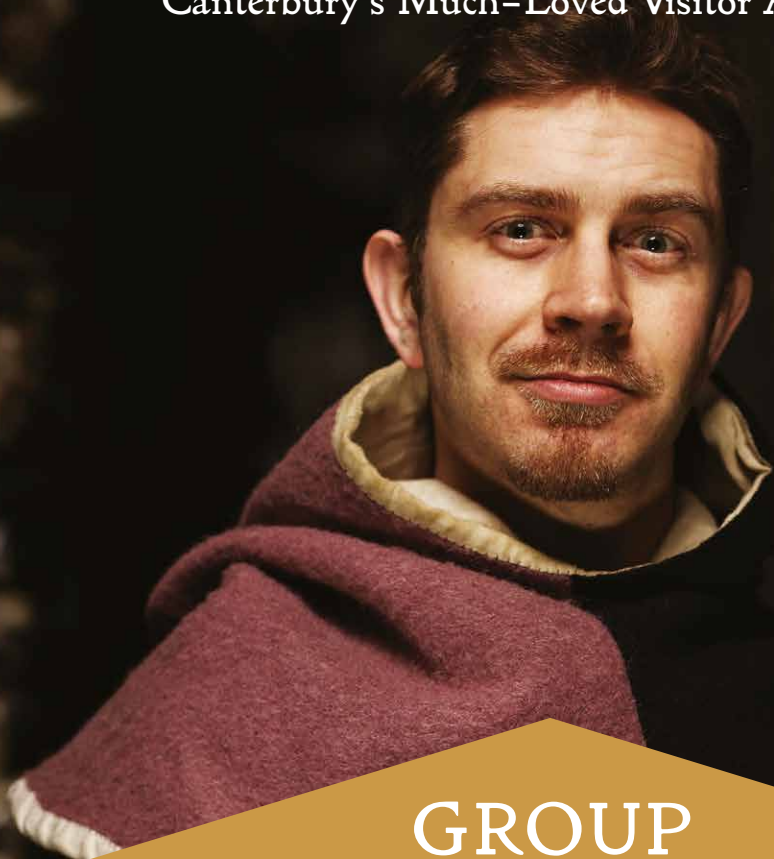

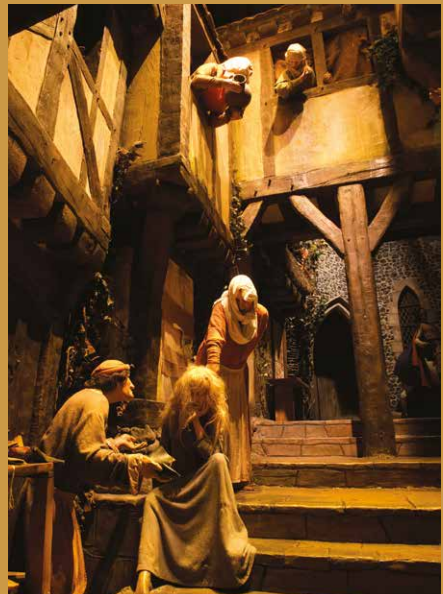

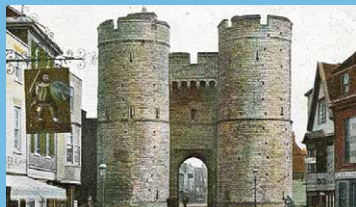


Explore more of the city by pairing your visit with a ticket to another attraction!

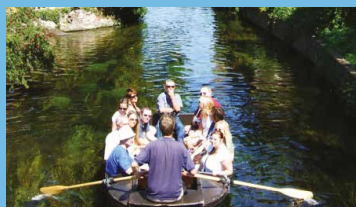
WESTGATE TOWERS

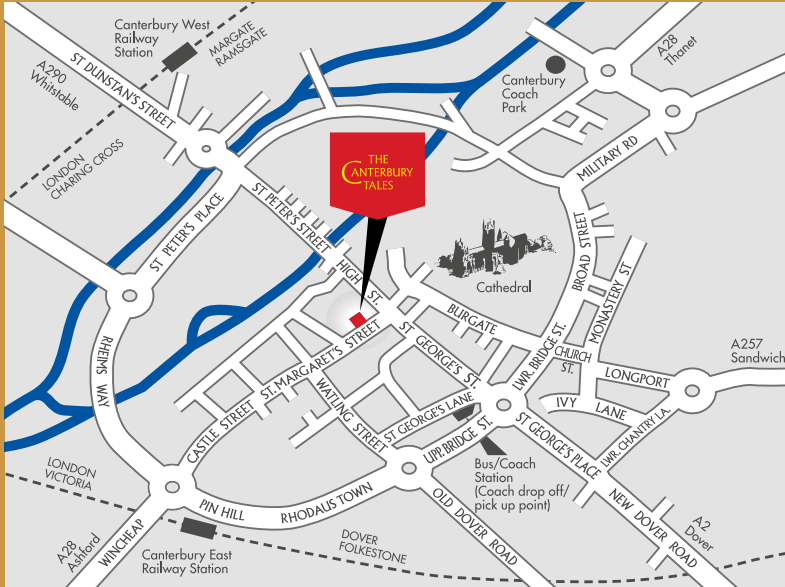

Whether you are walking from a local school, travelling by coach into the nearby bus station, taking the bus or arriving by train, we are easy to reach!



The Canterbury Tales Visitor Attraction, St Margaret's Street, CT1 2TG

Travelling by Coach: Parking is available at the Canterbury Coach Park (CT1 1BW), a short walk into the city, or drop off at the Bus/Coach Station (CT1 2TF). National Express coaches from London to Canterbury arrive into the Bus Station.

Travelling by Bus: Buses run into the city centre, dropping off at the Bus Station (CT1 2TF), just seconds walk from the High Street.

Travelling by Train: Trains into Canterbury East and Canterbury West are regular and reliable. Canterbury stations are easily reachable from most stations in Kent and from the rest of the country via London. Both stations are a short and simple walk from the city centre.
